

## Terms and Conditions Bonos LATAM Pass

### 1. Extra LATAM Pass Miles

- The mileage bonus consists of an incremental amount added to the earning of LATAM Pass Miles that the eligible member will receive for the completed flight segment.
- The bonus amount of miles will depend on the Qualifying Points goal reached and the route flown, whether within or outside South America.
- It is not necessary for the member to select a specific segment to receive the benefit. This benefit will be automatically applied to the first flown segment immediately after benefit selection, regardless of whether the itinerary includes round trips, one-way trips, connections or direct flights.
- The segment to which the mileage bonus will be applied must be flown before March 31 of the year following the year in which the Qualifying Points target that granted the option to select the benefit was reached. Otherwise, it will expire.
- The number of extra miles awarded will depend on the Qualifying Points goal achieved and the route flown, whether within or outside South America:  
**Routes within South America:** Domestic flights within Brazil, Chile, Peru, Colombia, and Ecuador. Flights to and from Brazil, Chile, Peru, Argentina, Colombia, Ecuador, Uruguay, Paraguay, Bolivia, and Venezuela  
**Routes outside South America:** Flights between South America and the United States, Canada, Europe, Australia, New Zealand, Mexico (including Cancun), Africa, Aruba, Costa Rica, Cuba, and the Dominican Republic, and vice versa
- The mileage bonus does not apply to tickets redeemed with LATAM Pass Miles.
- This benefit is only applicable to flights operated and marketed by LATAM Airlines.
- The validity of the extra miles earned for this benefit is subject to the current LATAM Pass Miles policy.
- If the member requests retroactive accreditation for a flight prior to the benefit selection date, the mileage bonus will not apply.
- This benefit can be selected from the date the Bonos LATAM Pass is obtained until March 31 of the year following the achievement of the Qualifying Points goal. This is applicable as long as no other benefit associated with that goal has been selected, or until the annual stock of bonus mileage amounts is depleted among all LATAM Pass members (excluding residents of Brazil and Europe). Please refer to the following table for more details.

### 2. Extra Qualifying Points

- The Qualifying Points bonus consists of an incremental amount added to the accumulation of Qualifying Points that the eligible member will receive for the completed flight.

- The bonus amount of Qualifying Points will depend on the Qualifying Points goal achieved and the route taken, whether within or outside South America.
- It is not necessary for the member to select a specific segment to receive the benefit. This benefit will be automatically applied to the first segment flown immediately after selection, regardless of whether the itinerary includes round trips, one-way trips, connections or direct flights.
- The segment to which the Qualifying Points bonus will be applied must be flown before March 31 of the year following the year in which the Qualifying Points target that granted the option to select the benefit was reached. Otherwise, it will expire.
- The number of extra miles awarded will depend on the Qualifying Points goal achieved and the route flown, whether within or outside South America:  
**Routes within South America:** Domestic flights within Brazil, Chile, Peru, Colombia, and Ecuador. Flights to and from Brazil, Chile, Peru, Argentina, Colombia, Ecuador, Uruguay, Paraguay, Bolivia, and Venezuela  
**Routes outside South America:** Flights between South America and the United States, Canada, Europe, Australia, New Zealand, Mexico (including Cancun), Africa, Aruba, Costa Rica, Cuba, and the Dominican Republic, and vice versa
- The Qualifying Points bonus does not apply to tickets redeemed with LATAM Pass Miles.
- This benefit is only applicable to flights operated and marketed by LATAM Airlines.
- If the member requests retroactive accreditation for a flight prior to the benefit selection date, the Qualifying Points bonus will not apply.
- This benefit can be selected from the date the Bonos LATAM Pass is obtained until March 31 of the year following the achievement of the Qualifying Points goal. This is applicable as long as no other benefit associated with that goal has been selected, or until the annual stock of extra Qualifying Points amounts is depleted among all LATAM Pass members (excluding residents of Brazil and Europe). Please refer to the following table for more details.

### 3. Standard Seat Selection

- This benefit allows the member to choose a Standard Seat at no cost on the flight of their choice before March 31 of the year following the year in which they reached the Qualifying Points target that granted them the option to select the benefit. Otherwise, it will expire.
- Once the seat has been selected, changes will not be allowed.
- This benefit applies to a single flight segment and not to the entire itinerary.
- After having purchased the ticket, the member can select the desired segment from the "My trips" section. The member must select a segment with a fare that does not include Seat Selection. Once the segment is selected, it cannot be changed.

- The member can make the Standard Seat Selection for another LATAM Pass Program member included in the same reservation through the "My trips" section.
- This benefit is only applicable to flights operated and marketed by LATAM Airlines.
- If the member activates this benefit and later achieves an Elite Category that includes Seat Selection at no cost as a benefit, they will not be able to change the already activated eligible benefit.
- In case of flight cancellation by LATAM, the benefit will be released, and the member can select another flight to use the benefit.
- This benefit can be selected from the date the Bonos LATAM Pass is obtained until March 31 of the year following the year in which the Qualifying Points goal was achieved. This is valid as long as no other benefit associated with that goal has been selected and until the annual stock of 300,000 Standard Seat Selection coupons is exhausted among all LATAM Pass members.

#### **4. Accrual on additional services on LATAM flights**

- This benefit allows the member to earn LATAM Pass Miles and Qualifying Points when acquiring additional services for the flight, such as: Instant Cabin Upgrade and closed auction, premium boarding, additional baggage, seat selection and same day flight change.
- The benefit is available from the day it was selected until March 31 of the year following the year in which the Qualifying Points goal that gave the member the option to select the benefit was reached.
- Once the benefit is selected, every time the member buys a ticket and purchases the additional services mentioned above, he/she will earn LATAM Pass Miles and Qualifying Points for the value of the service, discounting taxes and/or fees. More information about additional services [here](#).
- The same amount of miles will be accrued per dollar spent as the amount accrued for the value of the ticket purchased, discounting fees and/or taxes. In the case of Qualifying Points, the basal amount of points will be accrued per dollar spent on the additional service purchased, discounting fees and/or taxes, which will depend only on the travel route (domestic or international) and not on the fare purchased on the ticket. In other words, Full, Premium Economy and Premium Business fares do not have 50% more accumulation for the purchase of these services.
- This benefit, as part of a Bonos LATAM Pass, is available as of April 21, 2025.
- If the ticket is redeemed with miles or Miles + Money, and the passenger purchases an additional service, LATAM Pass Miles and Qualifying Points will be accrued for each dollar spent on the service.
- This benefit is applicable only for flights operated and marketed by LATAM Airlines and its affiliates.
- This benefit will be available for selection from the date on which the LATAM Pass Bonus is obtained until March 31 of the year following the year in which the Qualifying Points goal was achieved, provided that no other benefit associated with that goal has been selected, or until the annual stock of 230,000 accrual coupons for additional services on LATAM flights available to all LATAM Pass members is exhausted, whichever occurs first.

#### **5. LATAM+ Seat Selection**

- This benefit allows the member to choose an Economy Plus Seat at no cost on the flight of their choice before March 31 of the year following the year in which they reached the Qualifying Points target that granted them the option to select the benefit. Otherwise, it will expire.
- Once the seat has been selected, it cannot be exchanged for another seat.
- This benefit applies to a single flight segment and not to the entire itinerary.

- After having purchased the ticket, the member can select the desired segment from the "My trips" section. The member must select a segment with a fare that does not include Seat Selection. Once the segment is selected, it cannot be changed.
- The member can make the Economy Plus Seat selection for another LATAM Pass program member included in the same reservation through the "My trips" section.
- This benefit is only applicable to flights operated and marketed by LATAM Airlines.
- If the member activates this benefit and later achieves an Elite Category that includes Economy Plus Seat selection at no cost as a benefit, they will not be able to change the already activated eligible benefit.
- In case of flight cancellation by LATAM, the benefit will be released, and the member can select another flight to use the benefit.
- This benefit can be selected from the date the Bonos LATAM Pass is obtained until March 31 of the year following the year in which the Qualifying Points goal was achieved. This is valid as long as no other benefit associated with that goal has been selected and until the annual stock of 24,000 Economy Plus Seat selection coupons is exhausted among all LATAM Pass members.

## 6. Free Checked Baggage

- This benefit consists of an additional checked bag weighted 23 kg at no cost on the flight selected by the member before March 31 of the year following the year in which they reached the Qualifying Points target that granted them the option to select the benefit. Otherwise, it will expire.
- The benefit depends on the baggage conditions applicable on the flight date, found [here](#).
- If a member has connecting flights, they should check what to do with their baggage [here](#).
- After having purchased the ticket, the member can select the flight, either the outbound or return flight, to apply this benefit in the "My trips" section.
- This benefit is only applicable to flights operated and marketed by LATAM Airlines.
- The member can assign the additional checked bag to another program member included in the same reservation through the "My trips" section. Once the flight is selected, changes will not be allowed.
- This benefit is cumulative with other LATAM products that provide the same benefit. For example, if the member is already entitled to free baggage due to owning a credit card or having an Elite category, this benefit will allow them to carry one additional piece of baggage for free on top of what is already allowed by the other products.
- If the member has already purchased a ticket with a fare that includes checked baggage, they can add an extra piece using this benefit.
- In case of flight cancellation by LATAM, the benefit will be released, and the member can select another flight to use the benefit.
- This benefit can be selected from the date the Bonos LATAM Pass is obtained until March 31 of the year following the year in which the Qualifying Points goal was achieved. This is valid as long as no other benefit associated with that goal has been selected and until the annual stock of 15,000 Free Checked Baggage vouchers is exhausted among all LATAM Pass members.

## 7. Same-day flight change

- This benefit allows the member to change the time of a desired flight at no additional cost, while maintaining the same day, origin and destination of the original flight. Check more details [here](#).
- The benefit expires on March 31 of the year following the year in which the Qualifying Points target was reached, which gave the member the option to select the benefit. Otherwise, it will expire.
- This benefit is only applicable to flights operated and marketed by LATAM Airlines.

- After having purchased the ticket, the member can select the desired segment from the "My trips" section. Once the flight is selected, it cannot be changed.
- In case of flight cancellation by LATAM, the benefit will be released, and the member can select another flight to use the benefit.
- The benefit is subject to the conditions of service provided by LATAM Airlines.
- This benefit can be selected from the date the Bonos LATAM Pass is obtained until March 31 of the year following the year in which the Qualifying Points goal was achieved. This is valid as long as no other benefit associated with that goal has been selected and until the annual stock of 20.000 same-day flight change coupons is exhausted among all LATAM Pass members.

#### 8. Extra LATAM Pass Miles on your Favorite Route

- This benefit consists of an additional 50% earning of LATAM Pass Miles on the Favorite Route defined by the member in the corresponding section.
- The Favorite Route is defined as the specific origin-destination leg that a member selects to earn bonus miles. These bonus miles will be awarded for the outbound and/or return flight, depending on the ticket purchased by the member, as long as the selected leg is flown.
- This benefit will be applied as long as both the origin and destination of the flight match the Favorite Route selected by the member. This applies regardless of whether the flight is direct or has a stopover or connection. Additionally, the final destination of the flight must be the one specified in the Favorite Route.
  - *Example: If a member selects SCL - MIA as their Favorite Route, they will earn an additional 50% of miles for both the SCL - MIA and MIA - SCL segments. Additionally, they will also earn miles if their trip includes a connection, such as SCL - LIM - MIA, where LIM represents the connecting flight.*
- This benefit does not apply when the selected Favorite Route is a stopover or connection for that section.
  - *Ejemplo: If a member's Favorite Route is SCL - MIA and they travel on the route SCL - MIA - ATL, with MIA as a stopover, the member will not receive the 50% mileage bonus for the SCL - MIA segment. This is because the final destination of the segment does not match the final destination of the Favorite Route.*
- The benefit expires on March 31 of the year following the year in which the Qualifying Points target that granted the member the option to select the benefit was reached. Otherwise, it will expire.
- The origin and destination selected as the Favorite Route cannot be modified. It is valid from the date of selection until March 31 of the year following the achievement of the Qualifying Points target that allowed the member to select the benefit.
- This benefit applies exclusively to miles earned through the flight ticket.
- This benefit is only applicable to flights operated and marketed by LATAM Airlines.
- This benefit does not apply to tickets redeemed with LATAM Pass Miles or with Miles + Cash.
- This benefit can be selected from the date the Bonos LATAM Pass is obtained until March 31 of the year following the year in which the Qualifying Points goal was achieved. This is valid as long as no other benefit associated with that goal has been selected and until the annual stock of 60,000 Favorite Routes is exhausted among all LATAM Pass members.

#### 9. Excess Transfer of Qualifying Points

- This benefit consists of the possibility of transferring a percentage of the excess Qualifying Points earned above the qualification threshold of the Elite Category with which the member finishes the year in which the benefit was activated. Such excess Qualifying Points will be credited toward the following qualification period.
- The qualification threshold corresponds to the number of Qualifying Points required for the Elite Category with which the member finishes the same year in which the LATAM Pass Bonus

was achieved.

**Example 1:**

During the calendar year, a Black member accumulates a total of 130,000 Qualifying Points, finishing the period with Black Category status, whose qualification threshold is 100,000 Qualifying Points.

In this case, the excess Qualifying Points amount to 30,000, calculated as the difference between the Qualifying Points accumulated during the year and the qualification threshold for the Black Category.

If the benefit allows the transfer of 50% of the excess, the member may transfer 15,000 Qualifying Points, which will be credited toward the following qualification period.

**Example 2:**

During the calendar year, a Black member accumulates 80,000 Qualifying Points and finishes the year in that category.

Given that the qualification threshold for the Black Category is 100,000 Qualifying Points, the member does not reach the required threshold and therefore does not generate excess Qualifying Points to be transferred to the following period.

- In the event of retroactive credit requests, only those processed up to February 27 of the year following the year in which the benefit goal was achieved will be considered for the calculation of excess Qualifying Points to be credited.
- If the benefit has been selected, the member will automatically receive in their account the corresponding excess Qualifying Points related to the qualification threshold of the period in which the benefit was activated, no later than January 10 of the new qualification period.
- If a member selects this benefit associated with a LATAM Pass Bonus and subsequently qualifies for a higher LATAM Pass Bonus and selects a higher percentage of Excess Qualifying Points, only the highest selected percentage will apply. Consequently, the previously selected lower-percentage benefit will become void, will not be cumulative, and may not be exchanged for another benefit.
- This benefit is valid only for the primary holder of the LATAM Pass account through which the benefit was achieved and selected. The benefit is non-transferable to other LATAM Pass accounts.
- This benefit will be available for selection from the date on which the member obtains the LATAM Pass Bonus until December 31 of the same year in which the Qualifying Points goal was achieved.

Availability of the benefit is subject to two conditions:

1. The member must not have selected another benefit associated with the same goal.
2. The maximum annual stock of benefit selections among all LATAM Pass members must not have been exhausted, as detailed in the table below:

**10. Courtesy Segments for Cabin Upgrades**

- This benefit includes the crediting of one or more Courtesy Segments for Cabin Upgrades, applicable for flights outside of South America. The Courtesy Segments for Cabin Upgrades must be used by March 31 of the year following the year in which the Qualifying Points goal was achieved. If not used by this deadline, the benefit will expire.

- The flights considered outside South America are those that originate in a South American country and are destined for the United States, Canada, Europe, Australia, New Zealand, Mexico (including Cancun), Africa, and vice versa.
- This benefit is subject to the terms and conditions of the Courtesy Segments for Cabin Upgrades in effect at the time of selection. Please review the terms and conditions [here](#).
- This benefit can be selected from the date the Bonos LATAM Pass is obtained until March 31 of the year following the achievement of the Qualifying Points goal. This is applicable as long as no other benefit associated with that goal has been selected, or until the annual stock of Courtesy Segments for Cabin Upgrades is depleted among all LATAM Pass members according to the following table:

#### 11. Extra Qualifying Points on Full, Premium Economy and Premium Business Fares

- This benefit consists of a 50% additional accrual of Qualifying Points on tickets flown in Full, Premium Economy, and Premium Business fares.
- The benefit will be enabled for flights operated from the date it is selected until March 31 of the year following the one in which the Qualifying Points milestone that granted the member the option to select the benefit was achieved. If not selected during this period, the benefit will expire.
- Once the benefit has been selected, each time the member flies with a ticket in any of the aforementioned fares, they will accrue an additional 50% of Qualifying Points on the base fare amount, excluding fees and/or taxes.
- The benefit applies exclusively to flights operated from the date it was selected until March 31 of the year following the one in which the Qualifying Points milestone was achieved. To access the additional accrual, the benefit must be selected and active at the time of the flight.
- If the member does not select the benefit within the enabled period, or if it expires before the flight date, the additional accrual will not be granted, even if the flight was purchased within the validity period.
- This benefit, as part of a LATAM Pass Bonus, has been available since January 12, 2026.
- The benefit does not apply to tickets redeemed with LATAM Pass Miles or Miles + Cash.
- Additionally, it is applicable only to flights operated and marketed by LATAM Airlines and its affiliates.
- Extra Qualifying Points will not be credited for retroactive requests related to flights taken prior to the benefit selection date.

- This benefit will be available for selection from the date the LATAM Pass Bonus is obtained until March 31 of the year following the one in which the Qualifying Points milestone was achieved, provided that no other benefit associated with that milestone has been selected, or until the annual stock of 40,000 selections among all LATAM Pass members is exhausted, whichever occurs first.
